



The Sid Dillon Nebraska State Time Trial Championships

Course:

The race starts ¼ mile south of Yutan High School staging area. The course consists of a 24 mile out and back route starting/finishing next to Veteran's Country Club. The route winds south on Yutan Road towards Ashland. The road surface is in good condition, has minimal traffic, but is open to traffic. Law enforcement will be aware of the race and course marshals will be stationed along the course for rider safety. Click [Here](#) for a Training Peaks course map.

Background:

The Nebraska State Time Trial crowns the fastest rider in the Great State of Nebraska yearly. Win your category and take home this esteemed crown. Break it out anytime your riding pals start talking trash to you about how fast they are. Enter the Race of Truth. (Out of state riders are welcome but cannot win the state medals).

We changed the start day to Saturday this year to accommodate the Nebraska Omnium Weekend and to participate in the Flyover Series.

The time trial will be on Saturday morning starting at 9 AM, followed by the criterium in nearby Ashland, NE, in the afternoon. So, for those of you competing in the Flyover Series, bring your legs with you. This will be the full-blown 24 mile time trial, not some abbreviated short version

Register online at [USA Cycling](#). Online registration closes Friday, June 7th, at 6 PM Central time. There will be no day-of, onsite registration. Race will be held rain or shine, unless severe weather is apparent. Start times will be posted on the NOW website as soon as they are available, sometime around 9 pm Friday June 7th.

Only Nebraska yearly-license holders are eligible for the State crowns, but the race is open to all out-of-state racers too, including those competing in the Flyover Series. You must have a USAC annual or a one-day (\$10.00) license to race. The license can be purchased here: [USA Cycling license purchase](#). Sleeveless jerseys are acceptable. Helmets are required.

Triathletes are welcome to race. Come compare your speed to that of dedicated roadies. This distance is perfect for training for Olympic distance triathlons. If you have a USAT (triathlon) license and you don't have a USAC (bike racing) license, we will deduct \$5.00 off of your entry fee. Present your license at registration to receive your refund. Also, contact Greenstreet Velo Club (pduryea at cox dot net) about our GVC triathlon team.

Junior gear restrictions will be strictly enforced (as specified in the USAC Rulebook). All junior riders will be subject to a rollout immediately following their competition (clever riders check it ahead of time to be sure).

Time trial or triathlon bikes are permitted as well as disk wheels and aero helmets.

Schedule:

Start times begin at 9 AM promptly. We will have an official race clock. Be at the start line 5 minutes before your start time. Don't be late! Your time starts as scheduled whether you are at the start line or not. Racers are slotted by time in reverse-order of their registration, so register early to start the latest. Then you will have all the rabbits in front of you to pick off, one by one.

Remember, **NO DAY OF REGISTRATION**. Don't call me, don't email me if you miss the deadline. Don't show up to race if you haven't registered online. This will enable us to score the event without post-race confusion. Entry fee covers USAC \$3.00 surcharge. No chip timing this year. No refunds will be issued under any circumstance.

General Race Rules:

- All 2013 rules are in effect
- Event held rain or shine
- Place race numbers on the right side of jersey
- Approved helmets must be worn at all times while on your bike
- Valid and current USAC license must be presented at race check-in, which starts at 800 AM
- Held under USA Permit 2012-1403
- Race organizers reserve the right to cancel/combine events or pay out to only the top half of a field in the event of low rider turnout.

Staging area:

We have a brand new staging area this year. We will stage at Yutan High School, which is immediately north of Hwy. 92. We will have access to the locker rooms and showers inside. Registration will be inside. We will have volunteers to assist you crossing Hwy 92 to get to the start line by the Veterans Country. Podium presentations ASAP after the last rider finishes.

Note: Overnight camping in RVs or tents will be allowed on Friday and Saturday night at the Yutan H.S. in designated areas, courtesy of Yutan High School. Please don't abuse this privilege and "leave no trace" when you depart!
